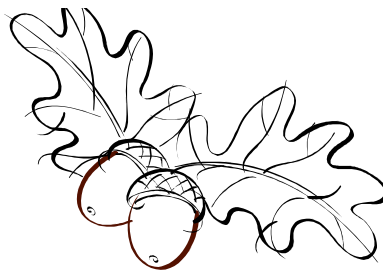
The Lehigh Valley/Reading Area SA—S-Anon Annual Marathon
